IOSH Health & Safety for Work Placement Personnel

The course aims to provide work placement personnel with the knowledge they require to enable them to review safety practices in the workplace, identify the hazards and evaluate the risks to which learners may be exposed and make recommendations to employers to ensure their safety whilst at work.

At the end of this course delegates will be able to:

- Understand the importance of a safe workplace and the specific requirements relating to young persons in the workplace.
- Identify workplace precautions and the criteria for types of workplace precautions and controls
- Know the statutory and in-house accident and reporting procedures
- Outline the main provisions of the Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974 and the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1992
- Identify relevant health and safety legislation, codes of practice, guidance notes and information sources such as Health and Safety Executive
- Define hazards and risks and understand the legal requirements for risk assessment

The course is assessed by means of a 45-minute multi-format question paper and a work based assessment covering hazard identification and recommendations for action. On successful completion of the course and assessment, an IOSH Certificate will be issued.

All delegates should avail themselves of a copy of the Learning and Skills Council 'The Safe Learner Concept' of which they should have a general understanding and all delegates are expected to bring to the course a checklist which they have recently completed for a sub-contractor.

The course is delivered over 3½ days. 3 days are taught with day 4 as the assessment day (am or pm session).
