City & Guilds – Unit 308 – Assessment of Risk at a Workplace other than your own (ENTO Unit D)

This is a 2½-day course, aimed at employees who will undertake assessment of risks in workplaces other than their own. This will include persons working in employment as work placement officers or assessing persons on work experience.

The course consists of 2 days training, followed by a half-day group assessment at an interval of approximately 1 month later.

Topics covered: -

- Key Health & Safety Legislation
- Accidents at Work
- Occupational Health
- Risk Assessment of Employer Activities
- Communication with employers
- Checklists and Action plans
- Common Hazards

Assessment is based on evidence presented from workplace visits (minimum 2 visits – one of which must be a pre-placement check). Documentary evidence must be available to demonstrate that the candidate has followed appropriate procedure for setting up and conducting the visit, together with any action plans for further improvement.

Eligibility will be determined by evidence of candidates having obtained one of the following course certificates: -

- NEBOSH National General Certificate
- IOSH Managing Safely
- IOSH Health & Safety for Work placement Personnel
