IOSH Health & Safety for Work Placement Personnel and City & Guild Unit 308 combined

The ideal course for delegates whose role involves them assessing learners in the workplace but who have limited prior knowledge of Health & Safety at all. This course helps the delegate to achieve the two main Health & Safety qualifications required in one 5-day course.

The course is structured as 4 days followed by 1 assessment day, these can be arranged in two blocks of 2 days followed by assessment one month later or one block of 4 days followed by assessment one month later.

The course is assessed by means of a 45 minute multi-format question paper, an assessment covering hazard identification and recommendations for action and an Assessment based on evidence presented from workplace visits (minimum 2 visits – one of which must be a pre-placement check). Documentary evidence must be available to demonstrate that the candidate has followed appropriate procedure for setting up and conducting the visit, together with any action plans for further improvement.

All delegates should avail themselves of a copy of the Learning and Skills Council 'The Sae Learner Concept' of which they should have a general understanding and all delegates are expected to bring to the course a checklist which they have recently completed for a sub-contractor.
